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18. VILLAGE ISSUES

Speeding Traffic

The Parish Council agreed OCC's suggestions and added that the 30mph limit should continue to the b4100. The Parish Council also resolved to request that OCC implement a 20mph speed limit through the village.

Playing Field

Broadband

An application has been made for funding for broadband in Bainton. Once funding is agreed, interested properties will enter into a contract with BT Openreach, and the service should be installed within 12 months thereafter.

New bench

The Clerk will arrange to order a new bench for the playing field.

Road resurfacing – Bainton

The Dragon patcher is awaited, but new potholes are appearing.

Defibrillator

Having considered emergency response times, the Parish Council agreed to proceed with the purchase of a defibrillator for Stoke Lyne, and once that is installed, also consider locating one in Bainton. The position of the equipment needs to be agreed with property owners. An approach is to be made to the Church, although currently the porch is locked at night.

The Clerk suggested that an application to SSE should be made for funds towards the costs of the defibrillators when applications for a Resilient Grant open.

Queen's jubilee

The Council will ask for volunteers to organise a village event, and agreed to support suitable proposals.
