27. VILLAGE ISSUES

Speeding Traffic

The works to reduce and change speed limits on the village roads have been agreed by OCC, and are expected to start on 14th November. The Parish Council was asked if it would prefer to retain the existing gates, adding new at the extent of the speed limited areas. This was agreed.

The new bench has been delivered, and awaits installation.

Defibrillator

The Parish Council agreed to purchase a defibrillator, to be installed on the wall outside the Public house, (Hook Norton brewery having agreed this position). The Clerk was asked to contact the brewery to enquire whether they had a contractor, who could be requested to install the defibrillator and connect the electricity supply. It has also been suggested that a defibrillator could be sited outside Sycamore Cottage in Bainton. The Clerk will request permission.
