## 18. VILLAGE ISSUES

### Speeding Traffic

The Chairman and Cllr Elliott have met with a representative of OCC, who has suggested that the 30mph on the top road should be extended. He has agreed to revert to the Parish Council with proposals and suggestions to ease the problem.

### Playing Field

The status of the playing field committee is to be discussed further at the next meeting of the Parish Council.

### Broadband

Final costings for broadband delivery to Bainton are awaited following a survey of properties that have indicated an interest in the project. Once the project has been agreed installation is expected to be completed within one year.

### New bench

The Clerk will try to match up a new bench with the existing bench on the allotments, on receipt of a photograph showing the same. It was agreed to look at funding sources for assistance with the costs.

### Road resurfacing – Bainton

The Dragon patcher has carried out some resurfacing, but residents are waiting to hear when the machinery will return to resurface the road at the blind left hand bend in the village.

**Marquee**

There have 2 requests to borrow the marquee, but currently there is little capacity in the village to assist in erecting this.

**Defibrillator**

There have been suggestions that the Parish Council should purchase a defibrillator. It was agreed the Parish Council would first consider emergency service response times before proceeding.

**Drainage near the Church**

There were concerns that the land drain in the entrance to the Old Rectory is blocked. The Clerk was asked to raise this with OCC.
