Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Stoke Lyne held on Tuesday 10th May 2022 in the Parish Meeting Room at 8.00pm

Chairman Nick Barnes welcomed parishioners to the meeting.

1 TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 22nd July 2021

The Chairman read out the minutes from the last meeting and it was agreed that they were a true record and were agreed as such.

2 REPORT FROM COUNCILLOR CORKIN CDC/OCC (read by the Chairman)

The full report is attached. Salient points so far as Stoke Lyne is concerned was read to the meeting.

2 CHAIRMANS REPORT

The Chairman updated the meeting with a synopsis of activity since the last Parish Meeting. He advised residents that the Parish now had a new grass cutting contractor, and asked they advise the clerk should there be any issues.

The Parish Council has dealt with a number of planning matters, including some large developments, including warehousing applications at Baynards Green and off the b4100 (currently on hold pending highways information) and the proposed Strategic Rail freight interchange by Ardley. A number of interested parties are working together on these.

Other issues:

Cllr Allen is pursuing the installation of broadband in Bainton, and the vegetation by the Peyton Arms has been cut back. OCC have carried out some road repairs, and have put forward plans to reduce the speed of traffic through the village.

Due to current ambulance delays the Parish Council has reconsidered the need for s defibrillator in both Stoke Lyne and Bainton. Siting is currently under discussion and it is probable that one defibrillator will be purchased shortly and located either at the Peyton Arms or the Church porch. Once installed residents should make the Clerk aware should they feel they need training to use the equipment.

The Parish council has put in a new litter bin by Lower farm and has a quote to remove the concrete base for the slide.

Finally the Chairman explained arrangements for the Platinum Jubilee celebrations for HM Queen.
